Scholarships for orphaned, vulnerable, and disabled youth are a vital part of the long term well-being for the communities served by Phelisanong. Talented students can apply to pursue secondary and post-secondary diplomas, leading to meaningful employment and a chance to bring needed skills to a region struck by calamitous losses due to AIDS. To date, 135 secondary and 6 post-secondary scholarships have been awarded.

Each scholarship is awarded based on merit, need, and a willingness to give back to the community through voluntary service during school holidays.

This is a project of Glasswaters Foundation, a Canadian foundation who facilitate indigenous communities to break the cycle of poverty through health, education, nutrition and shelter supports.
